AGM and Farm Visit Sunday 4 October

Sam and Can Hodgson farm at Glencoyne, a National Trust hill farm on the shores of Ullswater. The farms run to 2500 feet and is currently in a Higher Level Stewardship Agreement.

We have Whitefaced Woodlands, Herdwicks and Swaledale ewes. Most of the sheep are run with pure bred tups but we sometimes use a terminal sires like Beltex or Texel. We also have suckler cows - Limousins and Beef Shorthorns currently using a Beef Shorthorn bull. Recently we have introduced a number of Highland ponies onto one of the fells for conservation grazing.

To get to Glencoyne from Penrith: at the Rheged Roundabout turn left for Ullswater A592. When you reach the lake turn right, follow road with lake on your left. Pass Aira Force Waterfall car park and continue towards Glenridding for 1.5 miles. Pass a car park (Glencoyne Bay Nat Trust) on your right. The farm is about 100m past the car park on right. You can see it from the road.

If you are coming from Kendal/Windermere: go over Kirkstone pass A592 towards Patterdale and Glenridding. After leaving Glenridding go for approx 1.5 miles, as the road drops down to lake level we are the first turning on left. It is a white farm house with two big round chimneys. Do not rely on Sat Nav it takes you to Seldom Seen cottages!

Sale at Skipton

Everyone I have spoken to felt that this was a disappointing sale, with some good sheep there, but just not enough buyers and poor prices with many animals remaining unsold. Top price paid was 170 gns (\pounds 179) for one of Tessa Wigham's shearling tups. The highest priced of Julie Beardwell's ten shearling ewes made 90 gns (\pounds 95).

Judith Hawkhead reports: "I unfortunately needed my ewes to go due to lack of space, so my top price was £89 the bottom being £74. I think there were only two buyers so not a good attendance. Many sheep throughout the day went unsold."

Robert and Jean Price's prizewinning ram lamb was bought by Can Hodgson. Ram lambs made between 60 gns (£63) and 75 gns (£79). The three ewe lambs forward fetched similar figures.

Correction: Tessa Wigham's Champion sheep at the North Yorks Show was her ewe hogg, in the gimmer shearling class, not the aged ewe which was listed in their official results.
